Provincial Forestry and Grassland Bureau: Heroes Who Put themselves in Harm's Way and Ensured Daily Function of the Bureau Amid the Raging Pandemic

In March 2022, the COVID-19 resurged in Jilin Province. By May 19th, Chanchun, the capital of the province, had a total of 25 024 confirmed cases and 22 172 asymptomatic patients. Faced with the grim outbreak, officials and employees of Jilin Provincial Forestry and Grassland Bureau, no matter their rankings and seniorities, have assumed their responsibilities and rushed to the frontline of the battle against the pandemic. For over 50 days, when it comes to crunch, they have become a major force in carrying out community–level work such as sanitizing, tracking the origins, running tests, distributing daily necessities. Meanwhile, they have ensured smooth operation of the routine work in the daily fire–prevention, administrative review and approval, ecological preservation, and wildlife protection. Their heroic actions will be remembered as a vivid chapter in this saga of combating the pandemic.

Changchun Forest Resources Supervision Commissioners Office of the National Forestry and Grassland Administration: Jointly Fighting Against the Pandemic and Duly Delivering Supervisions

In March, to support local pandemic control, Changchun Forest Resources Supervision Commissioners Office (also the Management Bureau of Tiger and Leopard National Park) of the State Forestry and Grassland Administration, without delay, sent a task force of six CPC members to see to community work. This team have fulfilled their mission successfully, winning the hearts and minds of the locals. Meanwhile, they established a communication mechanism to realize whole–process supervision, which has improved administrative licensing.
