The short story has a tight plot, clear clues, vivid characters, simple languages and real emotions. It lays bare the cruelty of illegal poaching wetland birds for trade. The author meets Xiang Li (literally Fragrant Beaver), which is a civet cat on the island. The encounter triggers a lot of feelings and imaginations, and touches on the subject of "loving animals". The writing is delicate and imaginative, which shows literary finesse. However, the descriptions are too dense and trivia, and the tempo is slow and complicated. The language, which is a mixture of contemporary and classic Chinese, is too flowery to express something strong and simple.

## 70 Cormorant Flying on the Li River

This article is a departure from other ones of the collection; it tells the story from the perspective of a cormorant. The bird has developed a bond with a young girl who lives by the Li River. They care for each other and grow up together. With a unique perspective, this warm story discusses the possibility of a harmonious relationship between humans and cormorant.

### 76 100% Natural

The story tells the painstaking efforts of two golden swiftlets, Xiao Yan and Xiao Jin, to make their own nests, which fall pretty to the callous and greedy businessmen and the cruelty of the nest-harvesting business. The story is vivid and thought-provoking, a recommendation for children and teenagers.

## **82 Arctic Twilight**

This fairy tale tells how a seal escapes from a oil spill that pollutes the ocean. The gripping plot and vivid language, draws attention to the damage caused by marine pollution to the ecosystem and the threat to ocean animal lives.

# 88 Ecological Education in Full Swing at the Foot of the Gaduojuewu Mountain

Ecological education refers to the process in which the concepts and knowledge of ecological conservation are integrated into the citizens' education.
